

## **2.3 Gingerbread Software Upgrade for the MOTOROLA MILESTONE™ X**

- **Introduction** We are pleased to announce the new Android™ 2.3 (Gingerbread) software upgrade for MOTOROLA MILESTONE X. The software upgrade (Motorola Version.4.5.602.MB809.ACG-CS.en.US) includes numerous enhancements and improvements

The upgrade process **May Erase ALL User Data** from the device, including contacts, messages and 3rd party applications, and all settings values will be initialized.

### **o Save Contacts to SD Card**

1. From the Home screen, touch **Contacts > Menu**.
2. Either touch **More > Export/Import** or touch **Import/Export**, then touch **Export to SD card**.
3. Confirm export by selecting **OK**.

**NOTE: This is an OTA (Over the Air Update) You will be prompted to download and update for your device. If you want to manually initiate this update on your device, go to:**

After downloading and installing the Android 2.3 (Gingerbread) software release, you will notice:

### **Improvements**

<b>Calendar Application</b>	Various fixes were made to improve syncing, display of appointments, and updating of appointments.
<b>Email Application</b>	Exchange Active Sync and POP3/IMAP fixes were made to improve email reliability.
<b>Camera</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Autofocus Camera feature has been improved for use in low-light conditions.</li><li>• Geo-tagging feature was added to allow photos to be associated with specific geographic locations.</li></ul>
<b>Battery</b>	Battery life while using Bluetooth® has been improved.
<b>Call Back Functionality</b>	Fixes made to populate call back numbers in the dialer when coming from browser
<b>Security</b>	Included Google security fixes for DigiNotar certificate, libpng, and Bluetooth pairing.

**Enhancements:**

<b>New User Interface and Color Scheme</b>	New widgets, icons and screens have been added with refreshed colors.
<b>Dock Icons</b>	Icons at the bottom of each homescreen panel have been replaced with a new Dock. This Dock contains three swappable icons and the App Launcher icon. It is fixed to the bottom of all home screen panels for easy and instant access to your favorite apps and shortcuts.
<b>App Groups</b>	New App Menu allows creation of custom app groups, in addition to 3 default groups: All Apps, Recent and Downloaded.
<b>Improved Word Selection and Copy Functionality</b>	Words can now be selected via press-hold. A second press of the selected word copies the selected characters.
<b>Multi-Touch Key-Chording</b>	Numbers and symbols are available through keyboard shortcut combos, instead of having to change to the numeric keyboard mode.
<b>App and Power Management Details</b>	Manage Applications now provides improved information about what apps and services are running, how much memory and CPU time each are using, and the ability to close individual apps and services.
<b>Download Manager App</b>	New App will manage all of your downloads from web browsing, email attachments and other apps.
<b>Emergent Groups and Smart Contacts</b>	Based on usage, participant and addressee suggestions are made in Calendar entries, emails and text messages. You can create groups instantly based on the context of what you're doing. For example, quickly create a group based on a suggestion from a Calendar invitee list or the group of people with whom you're texting.
<b>Updated Calendar Options</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Calendar and event times can be displayed in your home time zone when traveling.</li><li>• Individual reminders can be dismissed, such as dismissing one meeting reminder without dismissing other meeting reminders.</li><li>• Easy conference dialing allows you to dial the conference number and the meeting code will be automatically entered directly from your</li></ul>
