

Bark for Android Phones

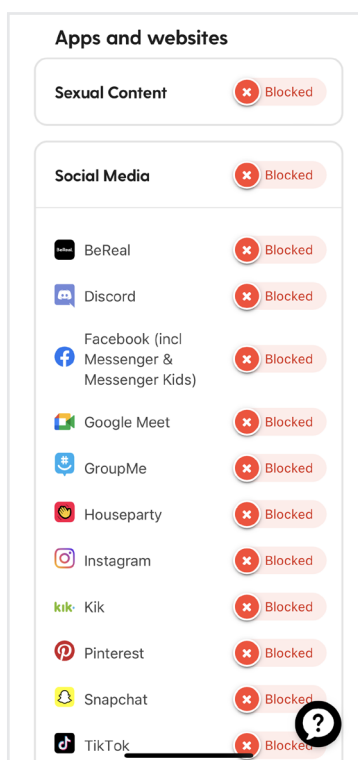
your easy guide to parental controls

What you'll need: A good WiFi connection, your C Spire account username and password, your phone, and your kid's phone.

1. Create your Bark account

- On the **parent's phone**, **sign into your C Spire wireless account**, and add the free **Bark Jr.** plan under **"Manage Plans & Features"**
- Enter your email address and complete checkout
- Look for an email from Bark and tap **"Set up my account"**
- Select areas of concern for your kid, create their Bark profile, select their devices, and set up parental alerts
- Go to the **Setup Checklist**, set up parental controls, tap **"Android Screen Time"** under **Remaining Tasks** on the Dashboard

Note: There are multiple categories and dropdown menus — we recommend scrolling through and blocking all (see pictured)



2. Set up the Bark apps

- Follow the prompts to download **Bark for Kids** on **your kid's phone** at bark.us/android.
Camera not scanning the QR code? Type the URL into the browser on your kid's device instead. You may see a warning that the file could be harmful — tap "Download Anyway"
- On **your phone**, download **Bark Parental Controls** app from the app store and sign in
- Sign into the **Bark for Kids** app on **their phone** using the device code from your screen and tap **"Get Started"**
Don't see a device code? Select "More" in the Bark Parental Controls app and tap "Get Device Code"
- On your kid's device, tap **"Open Settings"**, find **Private DNS** under Network settings and turn it off, and find **Accessibility** and enable it for the Bark app
- Accept all permissions and agree to the VPN connection when prompted
- Check that your parental control settings were pushed to your kid's device
If you used our recommended restrictions, apps like browsers, streaming services and the Google Play store shouldn't be accessible

Note: Prompts may vary slightly based on your Android device model
